


### Alert & Recall System

#### **HEMS** keep track of Alerts and Recalls.

Just press Search and EQ2 will find all likely Alert/Recall EQ candidates.Review Alerts and Designate Applicable, Not Applicable, or Not Reviewed

EQ2's Smart Alert Search(SAS) is
Complete. EQ2's SAS Search enables a
complete view of ALL Alert/Recall
Candidates with 2 clicks, even if they are
currently owned by non-nameplate
companies.



#### A single easy to use screen makes.


Review the Alert or Recall at any time. No need to open or close multiple windows to deal with one or multiple Alerts/Recalls.

#### A single click sets the process in motion.

After reviewing the equipment, one click issues the work flow and notifies the owner department or sets the Alert/Recall status.




### Alert & Recall System

### Alert & Recall System




**EQ2's Smart Alert Search(SAS)** process does the needle in the haystack search with just a click of the button. SAS looks across manufacturer ownership trees and ECRI's UMDNS device type classifications to clear away the hay so you spend your time dealing with the Alerts/Recalls.
